CHARTER FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN ... As you know, the Roman Catholic Church in the U.S. is very involved in the protection of our children. According to the Charter for the Protection of Children, enacted by the U. S. Bishops in Houston, Texas some years ago, every diocese and parish is required to implement a plan to help protect our children from any kind of abuse. In St. Patrick's and St. Joseph's Churches every person who is employed and every volunteer who has contact with children has been submitted to background checks, including myself and Deacon Noel Hinerth. In addition, we all have been involved in training to help us in our dealings with children. There is in the lobby of each church a brochure published by the Diocese of Ogdensburg, entitled "BECAUSE WE CARE," that describes the plan and gives information about reporting incidents of abuse to the proper authorities. If you wish, take home a copy of the brochure. There are more available.

CAMP GUGGENHEIM ... This summer be part of an amazing faith-filled and fun youth camp program. The Diocese of Ogdensburg Youth Ministry Center is hosting two unique summer camps. Young people seeking a classic camp experience are encouraged to attend Camp Guggenheim. Young people who want to improve their soccer or basketball skills are encouraged to attend SportsCamp. Both camps provide camp activities rooted in Catholic faith and tradition. The cost is \$250 per week and \$75 per child will be subsidized by St. Patrick's for active church members. If you are interested, there are applications and subsidy request forms available on the bulletin board in the back of the church. Dates fill up fast, so don't delay in sending in your registration forms.
